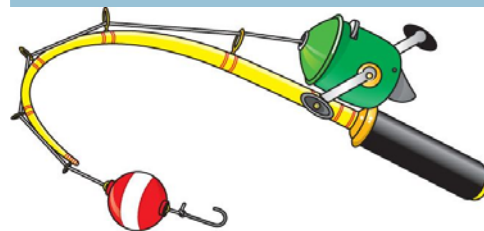
Hey Guys,

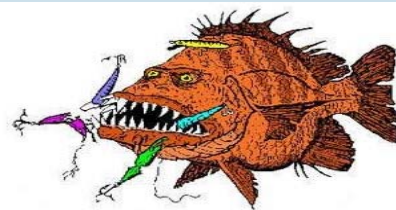

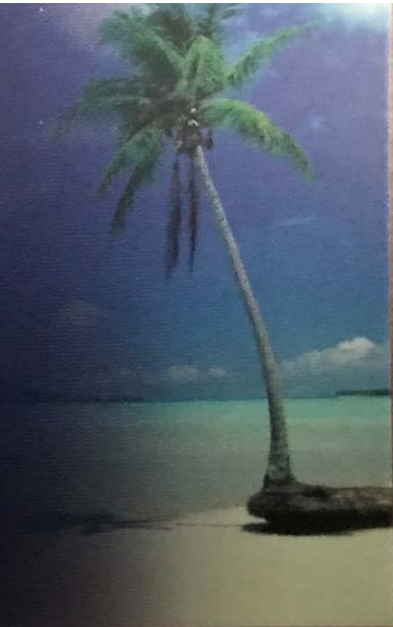
